MEDLAB South

Blood Tests - If you need a blood test, book your appointment at the Havelock Medical Centre. You don't need to be a registered patient, or travel into town. Medlab attends every Wednesday 8:45 to 9:45am, a Lab form and appointment are essential.
Ring Yvonne at HMC to book your appointment on 574 2233.

Health Education Grants - For eligible Pelorus Area residents on an annual basis.

Community Grants - to annually support our local medical and emergency services.

Mobility Aids - We have a great range of medical aids available for use in the community. We have wheelchairs, walkers, walking sticks, shower/foilet aids.

Health Advocates- We lobby to the government, medical centres, and other agencies to gain better health support for the Pelorus community

Disaster Relief - If you have been affected by disasters like fire, flooding, earthquakes. We have blankets, pillows, kitchenware, furniture to help where deemed necessary.
