

### <u>Marlborough Police Information – Crime Trend</u>

Over the past couple of months, a clear trend is emerging in Marlborough.

Vineyards and rural areas have been targeted by criminals - they are taking from vehicles parked in vineyards and other properties the **batteries** from those vehicles.

The latest event occurred over night **6 -7 July 2021** in Koromiko - **four batteries stolen from tractors**! The offenders entered a gated area, so gates are no barrier for these offenders. Other areas targeted - Wairau valley, Blenheim and Seddon area.


