Kia ora koutou,

The countdown is definitely on. We have three weeks until the start of the Area Schools' Tournament. Many thanks to all of you who have already offered your support. In those newsletters, I have included the draft draw so that you will be able to plan your week if you wish to come to watch some of the games. We will be using Saxton Field Park for the first day's games on Monday 20th March, as we do not have sufficient court space for volleyball and basketball.

We have a number of really busy weeks ahead. The Pelorus Cluster Swimming Sports are Friday 24th February in Linkwater for Years 1-3 and the following week at Stadium 2000 for Years 4-8. Our school Swimming Sports are scheduled for Tuesday 7th March. There is also an Awa to Moana Day for all the Pelorus Schools Years 6-8 students on Friday 10th March. This is part of the water week celebrations. Our students will spend half a day at Pelorus rafting and then move to Anakiwa for an afternoon of kayaking.



Downloading the Skool Loop app - a step by step guide

Once you have downloaded the Skool Loop App, via either your Google Play or App store, please follow the below instructions to select your school

- Open the Skool Loop App you will land on a welcome page
- Click the "Select your schools" this will bring you to a menu you can either search your school
 or follow the country/region prompts.
- . Once you reach your school, select it with the tick on the righthand side
- Tap the 'select schools' button in the top right corner
- Tap the big orange choose button. This will load your school and bring you to the settings page.
- Subscribe to the groups that are relevant to you, then click the 'go back' button on your phone, which will bring you to the main screen of your schools app.

82 new Attendance Officer roles created to keep kids in school

They'll focus on moderate absences, while support for chronic truants will also get a funding boost.

Families with kids who have a low or declining school attendance could soon expect a knock on the door from one of 82 new Attendance Officers -

and being away on a family holiday is not an excuse for skipping school.






The officers are part of a \$74million package to address Aotearoa's school attendance crisis.

They'll work alongside parents and schools to target students with moderate non-attendance, to work out what's behind the absences and stop them becoming a chronic problem

Part of the funding will also go to the existing Appendance Services, to help them reach an additional 3000 chronically absent students.

Duffy Books in Homes has come to Rai Valley Area School for 2023.


All students from Year 1 - 8 are eligible for 5 free books a year.


