The purpose of this workshop is to learn about the film industry and gain foundation skills in multiple areas of film making including camera work, acting, directing, lighting, sound and writing screenplays. Throughout this workshop you will create, plan and develop a short film with local filmmakers and tutors, and have the opportunity to work with Fredrick Pokai - The Hobbit (acting and directing) and Jordan Rivers - Avatar 2 (acting) and a couple of others who will zoom in to share their experiences in the industry. You will learn and practice film making etiquette.

This workshop runs for 5 days **Monday - Friday 10am - 5pm**, with a late finish on Friday for filming (6pm). The cost for the week is \$75 and will include morning and afternoon tea, Lunches and resources.
